Mountain dulcimer options and extras – special run 2025

Basic model - £750.00

- Kentucky or West Virginia hourglass
- 3 or 4 strings (fourth string placement to customers spec, double course bass or middle recommended)
- Scrolled headstock, friction pegs and violin finetuners in the tail
- Traditional diatonic fretboard layout with optional '6.5' fret for mixolydian playing
- Simple traditional soundholes – hearts, acorns, diamonds etc.
- Overhung top and back or simple binding
- High build, mid sheen oil-wax finish
- A selection of local timbers available
- Custom made noter in the same timber as the instrument

| - Fancy binding with purflings etc | +£50 |
| - Extra handmade noters | +£15each |
